

Keep your Mobile device Safe!

Many of our members know the convenience of Smartphones and mobile apps. There is an app for everything these days, and most are secure, if they are from a secure entity that you trust. But it's up to you to protect yourself. A cell phone is also a particularly convenient way to access the Internet. Did you know you can also connect your mobile device to the internet through a Wi-Fi network? This means that you will have internet access, but you won't be using your phone provider's data. But remember your internet safety! Saving a little money by limiting your data usage could end up costing you much more. Your phone can be an open target if you don't take precautions or know the risks. Here are a few things to ensure Wi-Fi security for your mobile device.

- Avoid connecting to unknown or non-password protected Wi-Fi networks, even if they are private. An unknown or unsecured Wi-Fi network is an open invitation for hackers, fraudsters and malware. These predators often lurk on public Wi-Fi networks constantly scanning for unsecured devices to infiltrate.
- You should only ever connect to a public Wi-Fi if you know and trust the network, and are confident it's secure and password protected. Using an untrusted and unsecured network could provide a gateway for total identity theft, or infecting the devices of your entire contact list.
- Turn off settings that automatically search for Wi-Fi networks.
- Be aware that fake or "evil twin" Wi-Fi hotspots are sometimes created in the same location as legitimate hotspots to specifically lure and attack unsuspecting mobile users. Always make sure you're on the correct network.

All the same measures and tactics for using your laptop or tablet safely on a public Wi-Fi network also apply to your mobile phone. Including using a VPN to route and encrypt all your data for maximum security. Have you added a password to your phone? This is one quick and easy way to add security. You can usually access this feature in your phone's general settings. Check your user's manual or manufacturer for exact instructions on how to better protect your information!
